

Terms of use for battery barrels

1. Free battery transport barrels are provided to distributors of portable batteries subject to the obligation to receive them under Section 56 of the Waste Act (646/2011) and who return large quantities of batteries weighing over 0.5 kg. The collection point must be supervised.
2. The barrel provided by Recser Oy is designed and intended to be used as packaging for transportation as defined by legislation governing the transport of hazardous substances. Any other use, such as collection, is done at the collection point's own risk.
3. Recser Oy's contracted carrier aims to deliver the barrels within 9 days from the day the order is recorded in the ordering system. A confirmation will be sent to the customer.
4. Only portable batteries compliant with the Government Decree (520/2014) may be packed in the barrel. Lithium batteries must have their terminals protected by taping or sealing them in plastic bags or film to prevent short circuits. Leaking batteries must be packed in bags.
5. Recser Oy's contracted carrier will collect full barrels upon request. Collection is arranged according to instructions provided by Recser Oy. Empty barrels are ordered along with the collection order for full barrels.
6. Barrels must be packed with clear plastic film on pallets as appropriate batches for collection and placed in the usual freight loading area of the collection point.
7. The distributor may not transfer barrels and the batteries packed in them to anyone other than carriers or handlers acting on behalf of Recser Oy. Batteries become the property and responsibility of Recser Oy once they are handed over to it or its designated carrier, and the appropriate marking complying with legislation has been made on the transfer document.
8. The distributor is responsible for Recser Oy's provided barrels to the extent that the barrel is damaged or lost due to reasons attributable to the distributor.
9. Current collection and pickup instructions as well as other materials can be found and accessed on Recser Oy's website. Familiarize yourself with the reception and packaging instructions before using the barrels.
10. A collection point that utilizes Recser Oy's organized system for transporting used batteries to processing agrees that personal data collected during the delivery/pickup arrangements of transportation vehicles (User) will be stored in Recser Oy's personal

register as described in more detail in the privacy policy. Recser Oy commits to protecting the User's privacy and using personal data reliably and in accordance with the applicable legislation at all times.
